Suggested Age: 4 to 6 years old Recommended for: 1 to 2 players




Required Resources

Objectives


- 1. Enhance children's spatial awareness and block-building skills by connecting the Beehive Frames.
- 2. Build sustained grip strength and hand-eye coordination by moving the Honey Blocks using the Bee Squeezer.



The bees had such a great "honey-vest" that their old beehive is now too small. So, they built a new one that's bigger and taller. Go slow and steady, little bees. Enter the gigantic hive from the side so the honey doesn't fall out.

Suggested Age: 3 to 5 years old Recommended for: 2 to 4 players

Required Resources

- A Elf's Hanger x 2 sets
- B Elf's Hanger Coloring Page
- Crayons in red, yellow, blue, and green



Objectives

- 1. Practice pencil grip by coloring the clothes on the coloring page.
- 2. Improve fine motor skills and finger flexibility by attaching clothes and accessories.
- 3. Enhance observational skills and spatial awareness by hanging clothes on the scale according to the design drawing.

It's moving day! Matilda bought a wonderful new wardrobe, but she's struggling to fit all her clothes into it. After a few sleepless nights, she decided to call for your help.

Let's start by drafting the coloring page. Next, connect the clothes to the Hangers. Lastly, hang the clothes in their assigned positions. Make sure to hang them on the protruding points so Matilda can find her clothes easily.

- Flashlight


Objectives
